COMPETITIVE DIVISION RULES (15 TEAMS):

All game rules follow latest FINA rules available on http://www.fina.org/sites/default/files/2017_2021_wp_rules_16032018_colour.pdf In order to provide to you the best tournament possible, and insure your security, safety, and of course fun & performance - some adjustments are done, and are recap below:

The tournament is composed of 2 divisions:

- Competitive where 15 teams will compete in the Georges Valley pool

- Recreational where 18 teams will compete in Roger Le Gall pool (except for the finale)

All players must be currently registered in accordance with the rules governing masters' Water Polo in their country.

A team may list 7-20 players plus up to 2 coaches on its roster.

If a team declares a forfeit or is disgualified for one match, the match shall be awarded to the opponent with a goal score 5

The duration of the game shall be four periods each of six minutes of actual play.

Time shall commence at the start of each period when a player touches the ball. At all signals for stoppages, the recording watch shall be stopped until the ball is put back into play by the ball leaving the hand of the player taking the appropriate throw or when the ball is touched by a player following a neutral throw. There shall be a intervals between period: 2-5-2.

The teams, including the players, coaches and officials, shall change ends before starting the third period and the second period of any extra time. Each Team will play a minimum of five games. No team shall be required to play more than two games in one day. Yellow card - given to a team or the pool (both teams) A warning that physicality is becoming excessive or signs of disrespect to

other players/referee, After a yellow card is given, the next occurrence will result in a red card.

Red card (misconduct/major) - given to a specific player or coach. Occurs after a second occurrence of any of the causes for a yellow card. Results in a exclusion and the player unable to reenter for the remainder of the game (also called «rolled» given the gesture used by the referee).

Red card (brutality) - given to a specific player or coach. Occurs when a player intends to cause serious physical harm to another player (punch in face, excessive head butt). Can also be given for any use of racial/homophobic slur, Results in an exclusion for 4 min of game time, the player unable to renter the game and a suspension for the next game (indicated by the ref with clenched firsts crossed at the wrist).

THE 1ST PHASE OF THE TOURNAMENT IS COMPOSED BY 4 POOL THE 3RD PHASE: 1/16 ELIMINATION ROUND BRACKETS OF 4 TEAMS, CALLED GROUP 1, GROUP 2, GROUP 3 & GROUP 4.

In each group, the 4 teams will compete against each other teams of the group. There are points attributed for each game: Win: 3pts / Loose:Opts / Draw: 1pts

Ranking is based on the number of points, ponderated with number of goals (G+ & G-).

THE 2ND PHASE IS A 1/32 ELIMINATION ROUND:

• 4th ranked team of a group meet the 5th ranked team of another group

- Each game have to determine a winner
- There shall be a penalty shoot out to determine the result
- The shoot out will begin immediately and the same referees will be used
- If two teams are involved the respective coaches of the teams will be requested to nominate five players and goalkeeper who will participate in the penalty shoot out; the goalkeeper may be changed at any time provided the substitute was listed amongst the team list in that game
- The five players nominated will be required to be listed in order and that order will determine the sequence in which those players will shoot at their opponents goal; the sequence cannot be changed.
- No players excluded for the game are eligible to be listed amongst those players to shoot or substitute as goalkeeper.
- if the goalkeeper is excluded during the penalty shoot out, a player from the nominated five players may substitute for the goalkeeper but without the privileges of the goalkeeper; following the taking of the penalty shot, the player may be substituted by another player or alternate goalkeeper. THE 5TH PHASE: 1/4 ELIMINATION ROUND

- The 2nd, 3rd & 4th ranked teams of the 1/8 elimination round meet the 1st ranked during 1st phase
- 1st & 5th ranked teams of the 1/8 elimination round meet each other.

- The 2 unsuccessful teams are 5th rank position

THE 6TH PHASE: SEMIFINAL/FINALS

In order to provide to you the best tournament possible, and insure your security, safety, and of course fun & performance - some adjustments are done, and are recap below:

The tournament is composed of 2 divisions:

- Competitive where 15 teams will compete in the Georges Valley pool
- Recreational where 18 teams will compete in Roger Le Gall pool (except for the finale)

All players must be currently registered in accordance with the rules governing masters' Water Polo in their country.

A team may list 7-20 players plus up to 2 coaches on its roster.

The duration of the game shall be four periods each of six minutes of actual play. Time shall commence at the start of each period when a player touches the ball. At all signals for stoppages, the recording watch shall be stopped until the ball is put back into play by the ball leaving the hand of the player taking the appropriate throw or when the ball is touched by a player following a neutral throw. There shall be a intervals between period: 2-5-2.

The teams, including the players, coaches and officials, shall change ends before starting the third period and the second period of any extra time. Each Team will play a minimum of five games. No team shall be required to play more than two games in one day. Yellow card - given to a team or the pool (both teams) A warning that physicality is becoming excessive or signs of disrespect to

other players/referee, After a yellow card is given, the next occurrence will result in a red card.

Red card (misconduct/major) - given to a specific player or coach. Occurs after a second occurrence of any of the causes for a vellow card. Results in a exclusion and the player unable to reenter for the remainder of the game (also called «rolled» given the gesture used by the referee).

Red card (brutality) - given to a specific player or coach. Occurs when a player intends to cause serious physical harm to another player (punch in face, excessive head butt). Can also be given for any use of racial/homophobic slur. Results in an exclusion for 4 min of game time, the player unable to renter the game and a suspension for the next game (indicated by the ref with clenched firsts crossed at the wrist).

THE 1ST PHASE OF THE TOURNAMENT IS COMPOSED BY 3 POOL BRACKETS OF 6 TEAMS, CALLED GROUP 1, GROUP 2, GROUP 3

In each group, the 4 teams will compete against each other teams of the group. There are points attributed for each game: Win: 3pts / Loose: Opts / Draw: 1pts

Ranking is based on the number of points, ponderated with number of goals (G+ & G-).

The 1st ranked teams of each group play are qualified directly to the 1/4 finals. The 2nd ranked teams of each group play are gualified directly to the 8^e finals. The 3rd & 4th ranked teams of each group play are gualified to the 16^e finals. The 5th ranked teams of each group play are ranked at the 13th position of the tournament. The 6th ranked teams of each group play are ranked at the 16th position of the tournament.

THE 2ND PHASE IS A 16^E ELIMINATION ROUND:

- 3rd ranked team of a group meet the 4th ranked team of another group.
- Each game have to determines a winner
- There shall be a penalty shoot out to determine the result.
- The shoot out will begin immediately and the same referees will be used.
